LOCAL AUTHOR RELEASES NEW HISTORICAL NOVELLA

In a nation divided, two enemies are united in this historical novella, *Charity's Cavalier*, by Isabella Hargreaves.

Brisbane-based historical romance writer Isabella Hargreaves recently released her new publication, ***Charity's Cavalier***, a historical novella set in 1651 during the English Civil Wars era.

Charity's Cavalier brings two enemies together as they escape to fulfil their destinies. This novella represents a change of historical era for Hargreaves, whose stories have mainly been set in the Regency period. "This story is far more an action romance than any of my previous publications."

Widowed during the Battle of Worcester, Puritan woman Charity Goodwyn dares to dream of an independent life, living with her aunt, un beholden to men. Sir Edward Lovelace, a Royalist, gravely wounded in the same battle, wants to live to serve his king again. Charity's only way to safely reach her aunt is to take the Cavalier with her, disguised as her husband, and helping him escape the Parliamentarian forces. What happens when Sir Edward unexpectedly recovers, surprises and endangers them both.

This is the sixth release by Ms Hargreaves in the last twelve months and she is starting to show her historical range, with stories also set in the outback Queensland in the 1920s as well as the Regency era. "And there are more eras still to come," says Ms Hargreaves. Historical romances occupied about one third of the romance book sales in 2014.
